East Bay Consortium of Educational Institutions / Cal-SOAP Scholarship Deadline: April 15, 2011

Awards: (amount of award will vary):

Approximately thirty-five (35) scholarships for students attending 4-year colleges or universities.
Approximately ten (10) scholarships for students attending community colleges.

Criteria:

1. **MUST have participated in at least three (3) East Bay Consortium sponsored events/ workshops/ programs.** Your name will be cross-checked with our student database.
2. Must be a senior who will graduate in June 2011 from:
 - a) Oakland Unified School District high schools
 - b) Berkeley High School
 - c) Richmond High School
 - d) St. Elizabeth High SchoolOR
 - e) Seniors who have participated in the East Bay Consortium's Pre-Collegiate Academy (PCA) at Merritt College regardless of the high school they attend.
3. Will be attending a 4-year accredited college or university, OR a community college.
4. Cumulative minimum 2.8 GPA, if attending a 4-year institution, or cumulative minimum 2.0 GPA if attending a community college.
5. Demonstrated active participation in extra curricular activities.
6. Financial Need.
7. If eligible, **MUST** apply for financial aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

If Awarded an East Bay Consortium Scholarship the following will be required:

1. Attend the East Bay Consortium Scholarship Award Ceremony in June 2011.
2. Attend a mandatory orientation at the East Bay Consortium/Cal-SOAP office in June 2011.
3. Volunteer Service (10 hours minimum) during the 2011-12 academic year.
4. Submit a Response Form.
5. Proof of college enrollment.
6. Financial Aid Award Letter (if financial aid recipient).
7. Upon graduation, submit a high school transcript with cumulative GPA for freshman through senior years.
 - a. Students will be expected to maintain satisfactory academic performance through the end of the academic year.
